### History of the Profession in Cyprus



- First University established in 1989
- Short tradition of training psychologists within national borders
- 2000 first BA in Psychology at the University of Cyprus
- 2004- first Department of Psychology, Uni Cyprus
- 2004 first postgraduate program (School Psychology) at the University of Cyprus

### Current Legal Requirements

### PTIHIOUHOS / Bachelors level Psychologist

- Bachelors in Psychology
- (Limited duties under supervision of a registered psychologist)
- Teaching and Research in Psychology
- Clinical interview in order to assess and refer

### REGISTERED PSYCHOLOGIST

- Bachelors of Psychology
- Post-graduate degree in 1 of 5 applied areas of psychology
  - Clinical, Counselling,
     School/Applied Educational,
     Forensic, Industrial
     Organizational/Work
- 1000 hours of supervised practical training
  - At least 500 hours before leaving the university

### Comparison with EuroPsy

- 2014 Approval for a NAC through CyPSA to award the EuroPsy
- In 2004
  - CyPSA successfully argued for overlap of legal standards with EuroPsy
- Current legislation was voted in 2009
  - Lobbying from other professional groups resulted in decreasing hours of supervised practical training to 1000
  - 500 hours short

### Licensing – Competent Authority



  - Registration Board for Psychologists –
  - members appointed by the Cabinet of ministers



### Registration/Licensing of Psychologists in Cyprus

- Once off registration
- Yearly License to practice
  - Renewal requires a fee
    - No CPD requirements
  - Ethics Code of the Licensing Board (under construction)

### Higher Education in Cyprus

- Bologna Agreement
  - 3 distinct cycles of training
  - Bachelors (4 years 240 ECTS)
  - Masters Postgraduate
  - Doctoral
- Accreditation Competent Authority
  - Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education

### Training in Psychology in Cyprus

- Psychology as a social science
- Departments of Psychology
- School/Faculty of Social Science
- Dramatic increase in the number of university programs and students in psychology in the last 15 years
- Specialization at post graduate level
  - No generalist psychologist training

### Programs in Psychology at 6 Universities













### Post graduate applied programs

- Clinical Psychology
  - 1 MSc (2 years including 1000 practical training)
  - 1 PhD (Scientist Practitioner Model)
- School Psychology
  - 1 MA / ISPA Accredited (3 Years includes 1500 PT)
  - 1 MA (3 years Includes 1000 PT)
- Counselling Psychology
  - 1 MSc (120 ECTS and 40 ECTS of Internship.
  - 120 ECTS and 40 ECTS of Internship.
- Forensic Psychology
  - 1 MSc (2 years with option for 1000 hours PT)

### Post Graduate Masters Programs Non applied programs in Psychology

- MSc in Educational Psychology
- MA in Educational and Cognitive Psychology
- MA in Social and Developmental Psychology
- A range of interdisciplinary programs
  - E.g. behavioral economics
